

DJ MROK | HIP HOP & EDM

MROK started producing, scratching and emceeing as a teen in the late '80s. Realizing he preferred being behind the boards instead of on the mic, he created Boston University's first hip hop radio show in 1991.

Over the next few years, MROK found himself drawn to the faster tempos of rave, techno and jungle. He shifted his production style and deejaying, performing these genres at official college events and local nightclubs.

After years of shopping demos, performing in groups and deejaying nightclubs, MROK's career kicked into high gear in 2018 when he returned to boom bap and classic hip hop. Since then, he has:

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

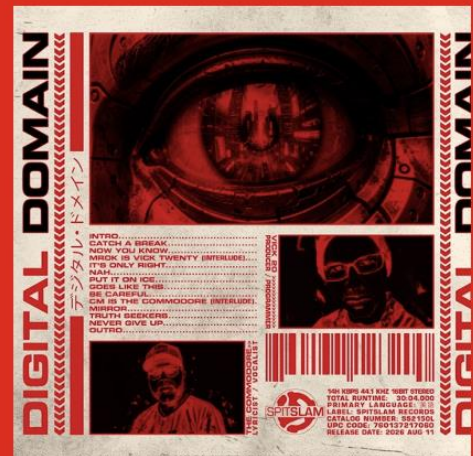
- 2018:** Fat Cat Beats selected MROK's beat tape, "Wax Nostalgic" as a "Hidden Gem"
